

Rules

1. EU-customs-public authorities volleyball tournament

1. It must be constantly 6 players and at least two women per team on the field. A maximum of 12 players per team will be reported.
2. Strengthen a team by "borrowing" a player of another team is possible only after consultation with the Tournament Director. Should the tournament director not be informed, threatens the disqualification of the team. A loan is generally permitted only if the borrowing team about otherwise could not compete on.
3. Beginning and end are the same for all playing fields by the Committee on or terminated the match. The last ball is not played.
4. Be played 2 sets with 10 minutes with paging.
5. At the games in the semifinals and finals, **two sets** are played to 25 points. Case of a tie in the pleadings nor a deciding set is played to 15 points. Achieved as a team's first 8 points so the pages will be changed
6. Each team must have a Board of Arbitration (2 referees, 1 scorer). The schedules are provided in the Schedule. Please bring your own referee's whistle
7. The arbitration court is responsible for the proper transmission of the game results to the game supervisor. The decisions of the tribunal are to be obeyed.
8. The referee should, so it does not lead to unnecessary injuries, game misconduct at the net always whistle.
9. The net height is 2,35 m.
10. Balls to play along and for the game Operation is to bring.
11. There are no formal substitutions (flying change)
12. The group assignments, the venue / field are found in the Schedule.
13. The teams must register with the Tournament Director before the tournament. There is then the current game plan and the rules issued to the team leader.
14. Changes are subject to the tournament, each team should be at the beginning of the tournament in the game supervisor informed about possible changes independently.

With the registration the participant accepts and confirms the exclusion of liability of the organizer for any damage to or loss of property. He/ she ensures to be in good health and in an adequate training condition. Furthermore he/she agrees that all

collected data for time measurement, video and photographic images can be published without any claim of a fee. All participants under 18 years of age will need a signature of their parent or legal guardian.
